

**The Avanti PRE Curriculum**  
**Exercise Sheet 7.1.5a (1)**  
**Group Work “Deciding what is Right”**

*The sheet may be displayed by the teacher (for all students to see) or copied and handed out, one to each student group. Work out in advance which question each group should answer.*

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Dear Student: Please answer Part 1, and Part 2 if you have time. Your answer is to one of the six questions listed below (the teacher will tell you which one).

**Part 1: What is the right thing to do?**

- (a) Should Arjuna have killed his relatives or should he have refused to do what Krishna told him to do?
- (b) You are walking along drinking a canned drink. You finish it. You cannot see a litter bin anywhere! Should you throw the empty can on the pavement? What should you do?
- (c) Its 8pm in the evening. You have to finish your PRE homework for the first lesson tomorrow morning. However, your favourite TV programme is on tonight (you won't have time to watch the programme and do the homework). What should you do?
- (d) You are visiting some friends of one of your friends. Some of them are smoking. They tell you to try it. Your parents have told you not to smoke. You know these boys will call you names if you don't try it. What do you do?
- (e) On the street, you find a wallet containing £500. No-one sees you pick it up. There is a name and address inside, but you don't know the owner. They don't live near you. What do you do?
- (f) You promised a good friend that you'll go with him to the movies on Sunday. Afterwards, a very popular kid at school invites you to a party at his house on the same Sunday. You are thrilled to be invited and you really do want to go. Your good friend did not receive an invitation. Should you go to watch the movie or should you cancel it?

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**Part 2: (Extension Question):** Reflect on your answer. Why did you give that answer? Does it relate to any of the 'ways we make moral decisions'?
