


Title: Ravana kidnaps Sita



LO2: To understand what a good leader is like, especially by comparing Rama and Ravana






What do these leaders have in common?

How are they similar or different?




## Book 3: Book of the Forest

- Ravana reaches Lanka and holds Sita captive in a grove of Ashoka trees
